Detailed description: This system contains measures 17 through 22. Horns 1 and 2 are mostly silent until measure 18, where they enter with a dynamic of *p* and then increase to *f*. Horns 3 and 4 play a rhythmic accompaniment starting at measure 17, with dynamics of *mf* and *f* respectively.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 23 through 28. Horns 1 and 2 have a melodic line with dynamics *p* and *f*. Horn 3 has a rhythmic accompaniment with dynamics *mf*, *pp*, and *f*. Horn 4 has a bass line with dynamics *mf*, *pp*, and *f*.
